

## Certification of Sanitary Transportation Practices for Human and Animal Food

The undersigned hereby certifies that all transport operations conducted by Ag ProVision, LLC, whether as a shipper, receiver, loader, or carrier, comply with the requirements of 21 CFR Part 1, Subpart O – Sanitary Transportation of Human and Animal Food. Specifically,

Ag ProVision, LLC certifies that all transportation operations are conducted under conditions and controls to prevent the food or feed being transported from becoming unsafe, including:


- Using preventative measures to protect feed and food from contamination or cross contamination by biological, chemical, physical, or radiological agents and
- Preventing the sale or distribution of any feed or food for which transportation conditions might have rendered the food unsafe until a qualified individual has determined that the condition did not render the food unsafe.

Ag ProVision, LLC further certifies that all transportation equipment used in feed and food transportation operations is:

- Constructed and designed to be suitable and adequately cleanable for the intended use to prevent the feed and food they transport from becoming unsafe (adulterated),
- Maintained in a sanitary condition to prevent the feed and food they transport from becoming unsafe (adulterated) during transport operations, and
- Stored in a manner that prevents it from harboring pests or becoming contaminated in any manner that could result in food for which it would be used becoming unsafe (adulterated) during transport operations.
